GOD'S CALL IN 2024

When I was a child, my dad taught me an important practice of writing down my goals. After my dad's death a few years ago, as my brother and I were going through his things, we found notebooks filled with goals. It's a practice that I have adapted and used though out my life and found so helpful in encouraging me on towards who I am called to be.

During Sunday morning worship on New Year's Eve 2023, I talked about what it meant to make spiritual resolutions for 2024. I'm sure many of us are thinking this time of year about things we want to do or want to do differently in 2024, whether it be physical goals, mental ones, or financial. I wonder how many of us also create and write down our spiritual goals for the year and found a helpful template in Mark 1 for doing so.

The beginning of Jesus' ministry in Mark 1 gives us a wonderful guide for considering what we need to leave behind and what we hope to discern going forward. Jesus' ministry begins with John the Baptist's call to repentance which calls us to consider, what do I need to turn away from this year? Next, the baptism of Jesus affirms our belovedness and asks, What affirmation of God's love for me do I need to hear in the New Year? Sometimes this is the hardest thing to hear: that God calls us God's child in whom He is well-pleased. To aid in this affirmation of your belovedness, I found this poem so beautiful and needed:

The Bravest Thing We Can Do by Sarah Are Speed

Trust your belovedness. Let it be a protest, an act of resistance, a song of celebration. Trust your belovedness in a world that is rarely satisfied. Wear it like a badge of honor. Speak it as confidently as your last name. Tattoo it to your heart. When outside forces chip away at your sense of self, when life asks you to hand over the keys, remember the water. Remember creation. Remember how it was good, so very good. Let that truth hum through your veins. Sing it so loud that it drowns out the weariness of the world, for the bravest thing we can ever do is trust that we belong here.

After his baptism, Jesus is sent out into the wilderness and, unlike the other gospels, Mark does not say much about it except that Jesus was tempted and attend to by angels. What is one place that God showed up in the wilderness this past year? Finally, Jesus calls some of his first disciples - What is one way God is calling you into ministry in this new year?

During worship I gave folks time to complete a reflection sheet with these questions. It is attached on the next page. I hope it will be a useful tool as we all consider our spiritual resolutions and discern how God is calling us forward in 2024.
