
MOTHERS OF THE FAITH

A 2023 study done by the American Bible Society "found that a majority of believers remain in the same religious tradition as their mothers. This agrees with a large body of mainstream social science research dating back to the 1970s that says the active faith of mothers is a strong predictor of religious transmission."



Mothers take an active role in our faith formation. Sometimes these are our biological mothers, but many times there are other mother figures who have had an impact on our faith: grandmothers, aunts, teachers, pastors, mentors and more. There have been many women in my life who have "mothered" my faith.

The Bible is full of stories about mothers whose faith changed the course of history. Think about Sarah, who became the mother of many nations, and Hannah, who entrusted her son Samuel to God's service. These women showed incredible faith even when things got tough. Deborah, is called a Mother in Israel.

Mary, the mother of Jesus, is another great example. She embraced God's plan with humility and courage, teaching us all what true obedience looks like. In Acts 9, Dorcas (also called Tabitha) was a mother of faith n her community. In Romans 16:7, Junia is named an an apostle - a mother of faith, indeed.
