FACING THE UNKNOWN

"Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to a known god" -- Corrie Ten Boom

Facing an unknown future is terrifying and we, as humans, often spend a lot of energy trying to predict what will come next, especially when something happens that shakes up our sense of stability and normalcy.

Corrie Ten Boom was a Dutch Christian who, along with her family, hid Jewish people amid the Nazi Holocaust. It is believed she and her family helped save over 800 lives. They were, however, eventually betrayed and found out and sent to a concentration camp. Corrie was the only survivor. You can read Corrie's story in her autobiography, *The Hiding Place*. I find so much comfort in her words, "Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to a known God."

I recently shared with my spiritual director that I was beginning to realize that life is really just leaping from one unknown place to the next, trusting that God is there to lead us one step at a time. While we cannot know what is ahead, we can trust that God goes with us. Jeremiah 29:11 reminds us that "For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." When I find myself in places of unknowing and feel the anxiety about what is next start to creep in, I often turn to one of my favorite quotes from Poet Rainer Maria Rilke:

BE PATIENT TOWARD ALL THAT IS UNSOLVED IN YOUR HEART
AND TO TRY TO LOVE THE QUESTIONS THEMSELVES
LIKE LOCKED ROOMS AND LIKE BOOKS THAT ARE WRITTEN
IN A VERY FOREIGN TONGUE.
DO NOT NOW SEEK THE ANSWERS,
WHICH CANNOT BE GIVEN YOU

BECAUSE YOU WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO LIVE THEM.

And the point is, to live everything.

Live the guestions now.
PERHAPS YOU WILL THEN GRADUALLY, WITHOUT NOTICING IT,

LIVE ALONG SOME DISTANT DAY
INTO THE ANSWER.

The unknown can sometimes immobilize us, leave us staring up into the clouds, like the disciples in Acts 1 did when Jesus ascended. They were stuck in an in-between space, a place of unknowing, between Jesus's resurrection and ascension and the coming of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2. But, in their unknowing, they turned to God and waited for their next right step. We can march forward into an unknown future, living our questions, rather than being stuck in them, because we can trust a God who has marvelous plans for us and is walking with us every step of the way.
