TRUSTEE UPDATES

All non compliant items from insurance inspection have been rectified. Insurance board confirmed we have "passed". Items included- removing range in kitchenette, installing glass K fire extinguisher in basement kitchen, inspection of fuse box to ensure safety. Fuse box was identified to be "double tapped" meaning two wires were going into single fuse, instead of one wire per fuse each. Outlet at bottom of basement stairs under coat rack was also fixed and is in working order.

Other electrical projects were requested for future including fixing the electric to shed, and work would ideally take place in November once Sorensen is on site since their items need to be removed/moved to make space for the technician to work. And lastly, I received an estimate for identifying all of our breakers as they are not properly labeled.

Sump pump was repaired, as the bulb for water level was not rising, causing the sump to not flush. Will need new sump installed in future- will need to fundraise for this.

Members helped weed the garden areas surrounding front and side entrance, as well as removed the broken and dangling Christmas lights on gutter of front door area. Thank you so much!

Boiler is in working order, however needs a new pilot light.

Julee marked the underground areas so stump grinding will take place within the next couple weeks.
